



TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION

'Club' means Subiaco (National Premier Leagues) FC Inc. trading as Subiaco AFC (NPL).

'Member' means:

1. the parents or guardians of any player that has not reached 18 years of age; and
2. any player that has reached 18 years of age.

'Player' means a child of a financial Member that is registered with the Club, or an adult Member.

By accepting an offer to play, or an offer for the Member's child to play, for the Club, the Member acknowledges and agrees to:

1. the terms and conditions contained in this document;
2. the Club's policies (available at subiacofc.asn.au), including its Code of Conduct; and
3. contribute in any voluntary capacity as reasonably requested from time to time by the Club's Management Committee.

The Member is aware that playing football, observing football, learning to play football, football training, and any other activity carried out by the Club, are activities that inherently involve risk, and that in undertaking those activities the Player does so at his/her own risk.

The Member agrees (on his or her own behalf and/or on behalf of the Member's child) to waive and release the Club's office bearers, officials, coaches, managers, referees, Members, Players, agents and other volunteers from all liability whether in respect of injury, damage or loss or otherwise (howsoever caused) to the Member's child, the Member or any other person, and whether that injury, damage or loss arises out of membership of the Club, playing football, observing football, learning to play football, football training, or negligence or of any nature whatsoever on the part of the Club, their representatives, office bearers, officials, coaches, managers, referees, Members, Players, agents and other volunteers, or otherwise.

The Member also agrees (on the Member's own behalf and/or on behalf of the Member's child) that the Member and Player has familiarised themselves with, and will abide by and be bound by, the Club's policies, rules, by-laws and Code of Conduct, as published from time to time.

The Member acknowledges that failure to abide by the Club's policies, rules, by-laws and Code of Conduct may result in the termination of membership from the Club, at the absolute discretion of the Club's Management Committee.

Fees are non-refundable. Refunds shall only be made in exceptional circumstances and shall be at the sole discretion of the Club's Management Committee. All applications for refunds must be made in writing.

Personal information collected by Subiaco AFC is for the primary purpose of membership requirements and/or competition purposes. It will not be released to a third party for commercial gain and will be maintained in a secure environment.

The Member consents to the Club posting images of the Member and/or Player and text that may mention the Member and/or Player on its web site and social media web sites.

The Member consents to the Club sending emails to the Member by use of an email distribution system, such as MailChimp or similar, and that those emails may contain messages from Club sponsors.

The Member agrees that if the Member's child has a medical condition and may require medical attention, the Member shall be present at all training sessions and games.

The Member agrees that in case of emergency, the Member authorises the Club to arrange any necessary treatment for the Member, or the Member's child, where prior notification to any parent or guardian is impractical.
